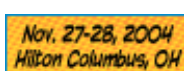

**FEATURE FILM, VIDEO GAME & COMIC BOOK PRODUCER JEFF GOMEZ TO TELL GALENA PARK HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS "NEVER SURRENDER"**

CEO of Starlight Runner Entertainment Supports Houston, Texas Area Youth

August 12, 2004 - New York, NY - Jeff Gomez, the CEO of feature film and cross-media franchise production studio Starlight Runner Entertainment, will be visiting with thousands of students and delivering his "Never Surrender" seminar at Galena Park High School near Houston, Texas on Friday, September 3, 2004.

Described as a "teenager's guide to winning at life," Mr. Gomez first devised "Never Surrender" in the mid-1990s when he realized that there were very few resources for teens to tap when searching for solutions to personal conflicts and challenges. The seminar presents key points in Mr. Gomez's "Life Adventure System" curriculum, which he started developing as a school teacher in the late 1980s.

In 2001, Mr. Gomez was called back into the system in the wake of the 9/11 catastrophe by then-New York City Board of Education Chancellor Harold Levy. For several months, Mr. Gomez performed "Never Surrender" for thousands of young people traumatized by the attacks.

A Latino raised in a single-parent home in Manhattan's Lower East Side, Jeff Gomez was often teased because of a mild facial paralysis, the result of a forceps delivery at birth. Escaping into the worlds of movies and mythology, he quickly became an expert storyteller and designer of fantastic realms. He would parlay that talent into a career developing such video games as "Turok, Dinosaur Hunter" and "Magic: The Gathering - BattleMage," and writing comic books that have sold millions of copies.

After forming Starlight Runner Entertainment with partner Mark Pensavalle, Mr. Gomez became a writer and producer of the multi-million selling animated feature film "Hot Wheels - World Race." He is now preparing to develop a series of major film and comic book projects with Romano-Shane Productions (Executive Producers of "I, Robot" and "Catch Me If You Can").

"I'll be telling the kids in Texas that I used to be sitting exactly where they were in the classroom, dreaming the same dreams," said Mr. Gomez. "I was lucky enough to figure out exactly how to realize those visions, and I'm going to use every minute they give me to tell them how they can do the same thing."

Mr. Gomez will also be visiting Freeport Texas High School and Clute Intermediate School during his trip on September 2.

"Never Surrender" has also been presented to such organizations as JP Morgan Chase, National Council for La Raza, and the OC Foundation. The engagements were arranged by Tony Cruz of Tony Cruz Entertainment.

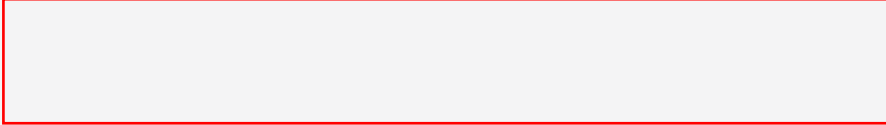
